Amounts Distributed to Date

The College has distributed as of the last reporting of September 30, 2022 the amount of \$302,316.00 of the HEERF III Student Share Grant Funds.

Estimated Number of Eligible Students

As of this date we estimate that 150 students will be eligible for the funds.

Method of determining which students would receive HEERF Student Share Grants.

Block grants were distributed to students to support their needs related to the disruption caused by the COVID -19 pandemic. Grants of \$1,000 per semester will be given to students enrolled based on financial need for the 2021-2022 academic year and they were allocated to students who express they were affected by the pandemic. Funds will be given to the students under the grant as long as the Grant remain. These grants are for the purpose of meeting emergency needs due to coronavirus and cost of attendance items during this time. Student's requests will be considered based on fund availability and for emergency needs related to student educational and living costs

Students will fill out a statement as to how they were affected by COVID.

Students will be notified once the monies are available for distribution and must be picked up within 7 days.
